WELCOME MESSAGE

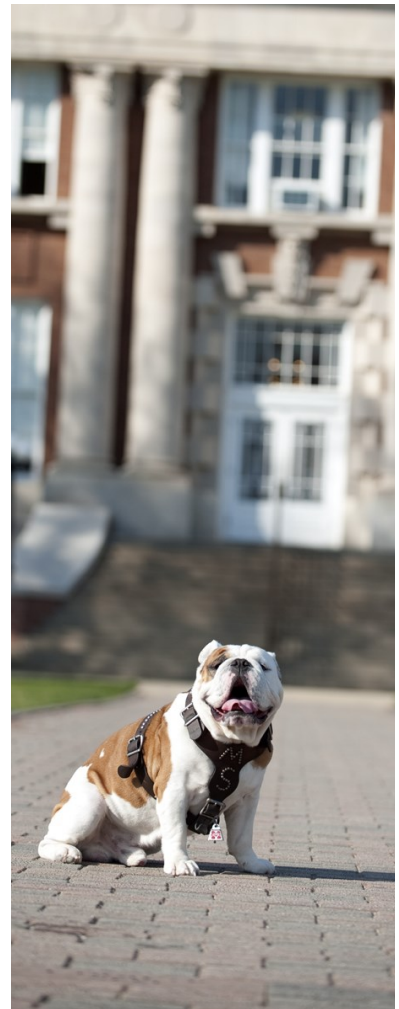

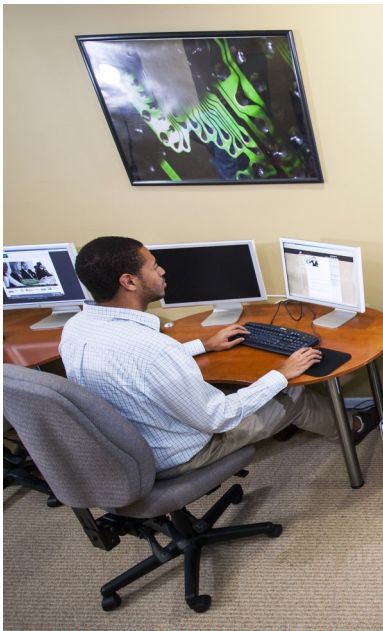

MULTIMEDIA STUDIO NEWLY OPEN

Located in room 254 of the IED Building, it houses 12 student Dell workstations that run Intel i7 processors with 8 GB of RAM. Each workstation is equipped with the latest software, including the Adobe Creative Cloud design suite, Photoshop, Dreamweaver, Premier and After Effects, among other programs.

"Our faculty now have an excellent studio for producing quality video lectures for these classes," Dr. Forde

emphasized. The department faculty and members of the MSU Advisory Council provided considerable input and support for the multimedia laboratory that will enable the continued offering of numerous courses via distance technology. DR. WEI-CHIEH YU NEW ASSISTANT PROFESSOR HIRED IN ISWD

Let's welcome Dr. Wei-Chieh (Wayne) Yu who will join the ISWD faculty in spring semester of 2016.

Dr. Yu received his Ph.D. in education with an emphasis in technology at Mississippi State University in 2008; master's in teaching English to speakers of other languages (TESOL) at University of Pennsylvania, and bachelor of science in business administration at the Ohio State University.

Dr. Yu taught at Chang Gung University of Science and Technology in Taiwan right after he graduated from Mississippi State University. He has published numerous papers and book chapters in various refereed journals in addition to presentations in many national and international conferences. His research agenda includes: social media, problem-based learning, instructional technology, computer-assisted instruction, computer-assisted language learning, and multicultural education.

NEW CURRICULUM FOR MASTER OF SCIENCE IN INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNOLOGY (MSIT)

Starting the fall 2015, the Master of Science in Instructional Technology (MSIT) degree offers a revised curriculum. This new update involves a choice of three academic concentrations: Instructional design, distance education and multimedia, in addition to 6 hours of elective courses. The new MSIT program is designed for graduates to qualify for more specialized jobs and careers.

Concentration 1: Instructional Design

The instructional design concentration emphasizes the design, delivery, management, and evaluation of learner-centered instructional solutions in a variety of settings. Potential careers include (but are not limited to): Instructional Designer; Curriculum Developer; Trainer/Training Specialist.

Concentration 2: Distance Education

The distance education concentration emphasizes the application of distance learning theories and technologies to the design, delivery and management of distance education. Potential careers include (but are not limited to): E-learning Specialist; Distance Education Coordinator, Director or Manager.

Concentration 3: Multimedia

The multimedia concentration applies multimedia learning theories to the design and development of learning solutions using cutting-edge multimedia software applications. Potential careers include (but are not limited to): Multimedia Designer; Web Designer.

ATMAE STUDENTS WIN SECOND PLACE IN ANNUAL HAMMERHEAD 500 BRICK STREET DERBY

The ATMAE "Hummerheads" built a gravity-driven Hummer and competed in the Hammerhead 500 Brick Street Derby held in Bay Springs, Mississippi, on April 18, 2015.

The team, which was comprised of Mississippi State University Industrial Technology students, completed the race with a second place finish in the college division.

The base of the car was a go-cart frame with the engine removed, and the students made other modifications to meet the race standards. Since the vehicle was only powered by the force of gravity, rolled down a brick paved road, the design was critical.

The students improved the steering of the Hummer by modifying the tie rods and front suspension. To reduce the drag, the overall clearance was reduced. The body of the car was built using half inch plywood and various trim materials. Once it was ready, the body was painted and attached to the modified frame. The students also enhanced several of the structural components of the vehicle to increase its overall safety.

The team outpaced a large field of entrants to earn an overall second place finish in their division. (4/2015)

GRADUATE TIME LIMITS AND EXTENSIONS OF TIME

The Office of the Graduate School just sent us a reminder regarding graduate student time limits and extensions of time. They are:

- Master's: 8 years
- Educational Specialist: 8 years
- Doctoral: 5 years after successful completion of comprehensive exams.

However, for those who were admitted **prior to fall 2010**, these students have:

- Master's: 6 years
- Educational Specialist: 6 years
- Doctoral: 8 years

The Graduate School now has two forms for students' use to request an extension of time. Both are found on the Graduate School website under Other Student Forms: grad.msstate.edu/forms/

A student whose initial time limit (see above) is expiring uses the **Request for Extension of Time**. grad.msstate.edu/forms/pdf_formsrequest_for_extension_of_time.pdf

The **Request for an Additional Extension of Time** is used by students in the one of the following circumstances:

- A student who has already been granted an extension of time and needs a second.
- A student who did not request an extension when appropriate and now needs an extension for multiple years.

TKT 9000 DISSERTATION RESEARCH HOURS

In order to ensure your dissertation is progressing in a focused and high quality manner, a new learning contract has been adopted for TKT 9000 dissertation research hours. You can check and get the copy from: iswd.msstate.edu/files/tkt9000_learning_contract.pdf

You are required to fill out the learning contract at the beginning of each semester for setting appropriate goals that you and your major advisor/dissertation director both agree upon. Your grade will be evaluated at the end of semester based on the learning contract that is signed by you and your major advisor/dissertation director.

We believe the adoption of this new learning contract can better facilitate you in the process of a dissertation for

developing and carrying out your dissertation research. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your major advisor/dissertation director.

TKT 8990 SPECIAL TOPICS

The ISWD has offered a series of special topic courses for the doctoral students who are or will be working on their proposals or dissertations. This past summer, a special topic in *Readings for Doctoral Research in ISWD*, that focuses on using content-specific scholarly journals and research-based publications to develop the theoretical foundation for the dissertation problem was offered. The second series course: *Writing the Literature Review for ISWD Doctoral Research* is currently offered this fall, and aims to assist students to organize and write the literature review.

The ISWD is currently working on possibilities of offering more course options for our graduate students, so our students can learn about all aspects of technology research. If you have any feedback or comment, please feel free to share with us.

MSIT: PORTFOLIO DEVELOPMENT

New MSIT Students Only:

Starting in fall 2015 for the new Master of Science in Instruction Technology (MSIT) program, the student is required to select one concentration area from: a) Instructional Design, b) Distance Education, and c) Multimedia, and complete a professional portfolio.

A portfolio documents your mastery of key skills from your courses. Since you will be compiling a portfolio as a part of the *TKT 8793: Directed Project and Portfolio Development* course at the end of your program of study, we strongly recommend that you save all the projects and assignments from your TKT courses.

ISWD AS CERTIPOINT TESTING CENTER

The ISWD is an official Certiport Testing Center. Students and other interested individuals may register and take industry certification exams administered in our department and proctored by our staff. Industry certification examinations may include: Adobe Certified Associate, Autodesk Certified User, Microsoft Office Specialist, CompTIA Strata, Microsoft Technology Associate, HP Accredited Technical Associate, Internet and Computing Core Certification (IC3), and more.

Test takers may schedule an exam by calling 662-325-2281. Group exams will be given on the first Wednesday of each month at 2:00 p.m. in the Industrial Education Building. 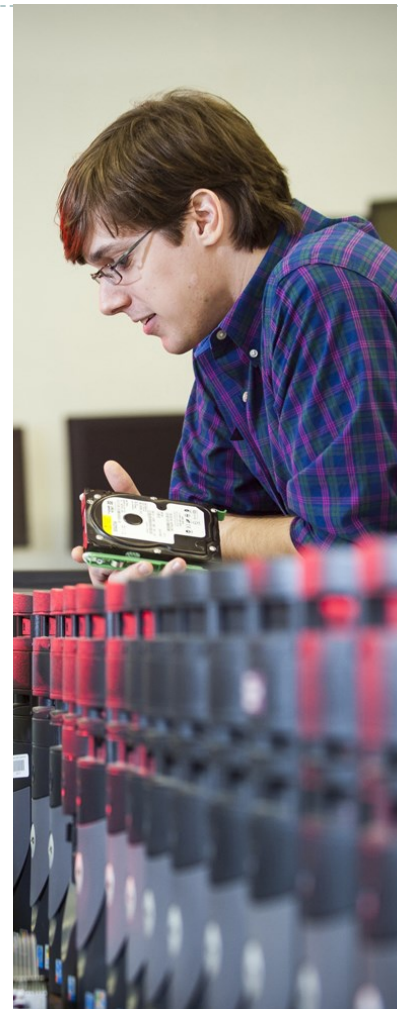
ISWD prepares students for a variety of potential careers in technology.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES

Due to rapid changes in information technology, the ITS faculty have proposed to revise the ITS curriculum in order to strengthen students' foundations and applications of information technology service (ITS), so our students can be more competitive beyond the introduction level. The summary of proposed changes is as follows:

1. Modifying the general education requirements:
 - Revising the Social/Behavioral Science: From the listed PSY 1013 General Psychology & PS 1113 American Government to "See General Education Requirement"
 - Revising the Humanities core requirement: From U.S. or World History and Literature to "See General Education Requirement"
 - Adding one more Oral Communication options: CO 1013 Introduction to Communication or CO 1003 Public Speaking
2. Removing:
 - TKB 1312 Information Resource Management
 - TKB 1123 Document Formatting/Information Processing
3. Modifying:
 - TKB 2122 Introduction to Database Management
 - TKB 2132 Introduction to Spreadsheet Design and Analysis
 - TKB 4543 Advanced Information Processing
 - TKT 4753 Presenting with Media
4. Adding:
 - TKT 4203 Emerging Technologies (new)

The new proposal has been approved by the College's Box Council Curriculum Committee in the spring semester of 2015. Currently, we are waiting for approval from the University Committee on Courses and Curricula (UCCC). If approved, new ITS curriculum would be effective as early as spring 2016.
